St Nics is currently between vicars, so it is my great pleasure to welcome you to our community! I am the Prior of the Community of St Cuthbert, which is based at St Nics, and on behalf of the whole staff team at Nics: we are looking forward to getting to know you.

Our church community is gathered from all around Durham city and beyond – people of different ages and backgrounds who seek to share life and grow in faith together.

We hope that you will soon feel at home here—whether as part of our services (either in person or online), as a member of one of our small groups, through one of our social events, or through getting stuck in and finding a place to serve as part of our church.

There's also an opportunity to find out more about the Community of St Cuthbert, where we meet together as small groups to support one another practically and spiritually.

We have a monthly Newcomers Tea on a Sunday at 4pm where you can come along and meet other new people and several staff members, and chat about what life at St Nics is like. Look out for dates, which usually include the first Sunday afternoon of every month – more often in the Autumn. Also on our website you will also find an opportunity to sign up for our weekly newsletter, which is the best way to keep up to date with everything that's going on every week at St Nics.

SUNDAYS

We worship together as a church family on Sundays, as well as throughout the week.

One service every Sunday is available to stream via our website, as well as on Facebook and Youtube – it is often our 11am service unless that features a lot of children's participation.

Our usual weekly Sunday services are:

9.00 - A positive and uplifting traditional Church of England service, that often include Holy Communion

11.00 - A lively contemporary service that varies between a Service of the Word, Holy Communion and All-Age celebrations, with children and youth groups operating as part of the service.

6:30 - An informal and reflective service, that includes Communion once a month.

DAILY PRAYER

Throughout the week we hold short prayer services led by members of our congregation. These often follow the Anglican liturgy for Morning Prayer which can be followed using the Church of England's *Daily Prayer* App. Services are live-streamed on our Facebook page, Tuesday-Friday at 9am. There is also daily prayer on a Monday lunchtime at 1pm.

During our daily prayers, we pray for members of our church community. If you would like to be prayed for regularly as part of the church community then please get in touch.





STUDENTS

Right in the heart of a university city, we love welcoming students into our church every year! As a student community we meet on Thursdays during term at 8pm, for worship and bible study, and we run various social activites throughout the year.

YOUTH

Our young people, aged 11-18, meet twice a week: on a Sunday and Wednesday night. Younger Youth (school years Y7-Y9) meet for Bible study and fun during the 11am Sunday Service. Our Older Youth (Y9-Y11), meet for pizza and Bible study at 5pm before heading to the 6:30pm service together. On Wednesday nights, all our young people meet for games and time together.
