


News from Argentina... and England:



Family news:

Following our final translators' team meeting in Córdoba, Michael was joined by Silvia and Chris for a short break, meeting up with a part of Silvia's family who live there.



Argentina, "Cita con la Vida" (Encounter with Life), so it was fun joining with them and meéting their pastors.



Chris tells us he's going to be coming back to live with us before the end of December, so we're praying he'll keep his word, and be free from the complications of where he is now. He's enrolled in a state-run virtual secondary school for

next year, where he'll be able to complete his secondary course work and even sit exams later in the year from England.



Kevin continues to do well at ICMP in London, now in the 2nd year of his course. He's worshipping at Westminster Chapel, where he's now part of the music group and plays every 2 or 3 weeks. Please pray for his

spiritual well-being, good health, a good rest over Christmas and the Lord's provision for the rest of the year and through into his final year beginning September.

Please pray for our house purchase in Liverpool. Not much is happening at the moment because first the seller's solicitor and then ours have been on holiday. We pray there will be no complications and we'll be able to sign the contract early next year.

Argentine Economics:

Javier Milei has begun his presidency with a whole batch of economic measures that he deems extremely urgent, to try and get the country's economy away from total collapse. In the short term, this will mean even higher inflation, with fuel, food and medicines all seeing very steep price rises. Deregulation



of a lot of the state's infrastructure will help industry and should generate employment. At least, that's what we're told. There's already a lot of unrest and a planned strike and march against the government next week.

Translation progress:

In our last team meeting of 2023 held in Córdoba earlier this month we finished the checking of Genesis, which we hope will be printed next year, as well as 2 Samuel and Psalms. Genesis was a much easier book than Psalms, and the translators were particularly

Michael hopes to be able to make occasional visits to Argentina, maybe once a year. Our hope is to finish by the end of 2025.

Please pray for the Lord's protection in the spiritual battle we face as we seek to translate God's Word; for his strength to enable us to keep moving ahead, and that our good working relationship as a team may continue to the end. Pray for good health for us all and our families; give thanks for the Lord's daily provision: even in the midst of Argentina's frequent crises, he never lets us down. God is faithful!

Pray for Kevin in his studies, for Chris to get back into his; for our house purchase in Liverpool and our move early next year.
