

Why not swap your sheep with someone else in your household and then it will remind you to pray to God for them daily.



## Food challenge

The challenge this time is to make a celebration cake. Here is a microwave mug cake recipe from BBC GoodFood. See what you have at home that you can decorate it with.

### Ingredients:

4 tbsp self-raising flour

4 tbsp caster sugar

2 tbsp cocoa powder

1 medium egg

3 tbsp milk

3 tbsp vegetable or sunflower oil

a few drops of vanilla essence

2 tbsp chocolate chips, nuts, or raisins etc (optional)

### Method:

#### Step 1:

Add 4 *tbsp self-raising flour*, 4 *tbsp caster sugar* and 2 *tbsp cocoa powder* to the largest mug you have (to stop it overflowing in the microwave) and mix.

#### Step 2:

Add 1 *medium egg* and mix in as much as you can, but don't worry if there's still dry mix left.

#### Step 3:

Add the 3 *tbsp milk*, 3 *tbsp vegetable or sunflower oil* and a few drops of *vanilla essence* and mix until smooth, before adding 2 *tbsp chocolate chips, nuts, or raisins*, if using, and mix again.

#### Step 4:

Centre your mug in the middle of the microwave oven and cook on **high for 1½-2 mins**, or until it has stopped rising and is firm to the touch. Then decorate as you wish.






Praise is our way of telling God how AMAZING He is. We can praise using our words, our actions and our whole bodies.


We can praise God wherever we go, why not go for a walk together in God's amazing creation. How many different things can you see that you can praise and thank God for?


### Let's make a Thank You catcher!

#### You will need:


- A4 paper


Take your sheet of A4 paper and fold up one corner until it meets the other side. Fold opposite corner up and cut off the excess strip to leave you with a square.

2




Unfold then fold each corner so the points meet in the middle.

3




It should look like this. Now flip it over and fold in the corners so the points meet in the middle.

Fold along the horizontal middle and then the vertical middle.

Open the Thank You Catcher and work the sections with your fingers to form four points.

On the four outer flaps write the names of four different colours. On the inside, write eight numbers on the triangle flaps. Lift the flaps and write something you might want to say Thank You for on each one.

For example: • school • family  
• free choice • friends • gifts • pets  
• creation • sports





## Food challenge

Today we are making **Torpedo Pizzas**.

### We need to use the oven.

Switch it on to about 180 degrees Centigrade.

We need a couple of bread rolls that are cut in half and placed cut side up on a baking tray.

Place a table spoonful of any pasta sauce on the roll. Then go creative with any toppings that you fancy:

*Cheese and Pineapple? Ham and Cheese?*

*Olives and Cheese?*

*Cheese and finely chopped onion?*

- Chopped onion





### Let's chat!





There are many ways to pray. Using words, being silent, drawing, singing or dancing.


What is the best way for you to pray?

The picture on *sheet 2* is a *labyrinth*. It is a special, silent way of praying.

## Food Challenge

Coconut ice - can you get the colour right?

### Ingredients:

200g Carnation condensed milk

225g sieved icing sugar

175g Desiccated coconut

A tiny drop of red food colouring

### Method:

#### Step 1:

Mix together the condensed milk and icing sugar. Stir in the coconut and divide the mixture in half. Colour one half a pale pink.

#### Step 2:


Double line a small plastic box with cling film before placing the white mixture in the bottom, pressing it into a bar shape.

#### Step 3:

Form the pink mixture into a similar shape and press firmly together.

#### Step 4:

Chill in the fridge for 1-2 hours until firm then cut into squares.



### Ingredients:


- tortilla wraps • cheese • thin sliced ham • pieces of cut tomatoes • salt and pepper

- Bake in the oven for 10 to 12 minutes and enjoy.








Let's make a treasure box.

- 2 cups of granulated sugar

- In a large sturdy saucepan combine the sugar, butter, milk and cocoa.
- Bring to the boil over a medium heat stirring frequently.
- Continue boiling for three minutes. Be very careful, it will get very hot. Keep stirring frequently.
- Remove from the heat and stir in the oats.
- Drop a tablespoon of the mixture on to wax paper and allow to cool.



### Let's make!

#### Happy & sad face plates

So, we are using the plate to make: on one side a really happy face with a big red smile and on the other side a really unhappy face with a very down turned mouth.

Once you've drawn both faces, stick the hair on so that it is long enough to hang down both side of the plate.

When the plate is mounted on the stick you can turn the face from sad to happy very quickly. Just like in the story where the man thought he had an ordinary field but then was happy when he found the treasure in it.

#### You will need:

- A small paper plate
- Two sets of googly eyes (or you could use old buttons)
- Some UPV glue
- A red marker,
- Some pieces of wool to make hair
- Either a lolly pop stick or a piece of doweling to mount the faces on.

## Food Challenge!


Often made at Easter these are a real easy treat

### You will need:

- 200g milk chocolate, broken into pieces
- 85g shredded wheat, crushed
- 2 x 100g bags mini chocolate eggs
- cupcake cases


### Method:

- **STEP 1**  
Melt the chocolate in a small bowl placed over a pan of barely simmering water. Pour the chocolate over the shredded wheat and stir well to combine.
- **STEP 2**  
Spoon the chocolate wheat into 12 cupcake cases and press the back of a teaspoon in the centre to create a nest shape. Place 3 mini chocolate eggs on top of each nest. Chill the nests in the fridge for 2 hrs until set.




## Let's Make!

A **wind chime**.

### You will need:

- a stick about 12" long
- garden twine
- a selection of 12 large buttons that can be threaded with the garden twine so that they can hang from the stick in four separate lengths
- cotton thread



- Take your stick and secure a good length of twine at both ends to make a hanging loop. (*Doubling the piece of twine will help.*) You need to make sure the hanging loop does not slip off of the stick, so you may need to use some glue or sticky tape.
- Next, cut four different lengths of twine that will enable you to thread on three buttons at different places on each thread. Secure each one with cotton onto the twine and then secure each length to the main stick.
- Hang securely onto a tree and listen to the sound it makes in the wind and watch its movements.

## Food challenge

### Surprise Cupcakes

#### Ingredients:

175g unsalted butter  
175g caster sugar  
1 tsp vanilla extract  
3 eggs  
175g self-raising flour  
50ml milk

a multi-coloured selection of sprinkles

#### For the buttercream:

225g unsalted butter, softened  
1 tsp vanilla extract  
375g icing sugar  
25g white chocolate, melted

#### Method:


**Step 1:** Preheat the oven to gas 4/180°C/fan 160°C. Line a muffin tin with 12 paper cases. In a bowl, beat the butter and sugar until light and fluffy. Add the vanilla extract then beat in the eggs, one by one, each with a spoonful of flour, until smooth. Fold in the remaining flour, then stir in the milk until just combined. Divide between the cases.

**Step 2:** Bake for 20-25 mins. Cool on a wire rack.

**Step 3:** For the buttercream, beat the butter in a bowl until pale and creamy, then add the vanilla extract. Add the icing sugar in stages, beating between each addition, until combined. Stir in the melted white chocolate.

**Step 4:** Leaving the bases intact, use a teaspoon to remove a little of the sponge from the middle of each cake. Mix the sprinkles together, then spoon about 1 tsp into each hole.


**Step 5:** Spoon the icing into a piping bag with a round (1cm) nozzle and pipe a swirl onto each cupcake. Decorate with more of the sprinkle mixture. The iced cupcakes will last for 3 days in a sealed container.

# Pentecost

### It's in the Bible

### Let's chat! Watch the video: *The Power Cut*

Which bit of the Panda show did you like best today?

Was there anything that you didn't like in it? I wonder why that was?

Well the theme to day is *Pentecost* or another way of putting it is '*The birthday of the Church*'

### Let's make a party!


#### Let's make Decorations!

You may like to make lots of paper chains to decorate your room. Why not write on them the names of all the people you know in your church family.

You might like to make bunting in red and yellow colours out of different sizes of triangle using paper or material if you have any. Then staple them onto a long piece of ribbon or string.

#### Let's make party hats!

You will need a piece of orange card two inches in depth and long enough to fit around your head. When you have measured it staple the ends together.





Colour in the flame template, cut it out and staple it in the front of the head band.

## Food challenge!

Let's make party food! Here is just one easy idea: **Marshmallow lollies**

### Method

#### STEP 1

- Heat the chocolate in separate bowls over simmering water or on a low setting in the microwave.
- Allow to cool a little.

#### STEP 2

- Put your chosen sprinkles on separate plates.
- Push a kebab stick or lolly stick into a marshmallow about half way in.
- Dip into the white or milk chocolate, allow the excess to drip off then dip into the sprinkles of your choice.
- Put into a tall glass to set. Repeat with each marshmallow

### You will need:

- 50g white chocolate
- 50g milk chocolate
- selection of cake sprinkles
- 1 bag marshmallows (about 200g) use the big ones if possible
- 1 pack lollipop sticks or kebab sticks





## Let's play a game!

### How to play:

- Everyone sits in a circle.
- People take it in turn to throw the dice.
- If you throw a six you have to get dressed in all the clothes, pick up the knife and fork, and start to cut the chocolate bar open and eat the chocolate.
- You keep on going until another six is thrown, then someone else takes over.
- If you wanted to you could use two dice starting in two different points in the circle.

### You will need:

- A dice
- A covered bar of chocolate
- Some gloves
- A scarf
- A woolly hat
- A jacket
- Knife and fork
