

Climate change 'cause of most underreported humanitarian crises'

Report says few headlines sparked by food crises that ravaged Madagascar, Ethiopia and Haiti

2. Surely humans can't change the global climate?



Romans 8:19-21


Jesus is creation's saviour & hope
